BFIS Bermuda College Scholarship APPLICATION CRITERIA

BFIS Scholarships for Bermuda College students taking one of the following:

**Associate in Arts (Business Administration)
Associate in Business Administration
Associate in Science (Actuarial)**

Students should be interested in pursuing a career in insurance, actuarial science or finance or be employed in the insurance industry.

AWARDED	Annually.
AGE	No age restriction.
BENEFITS	Scholarships, valued at \$3,000 per annum and tenable for up to two years, are offered to suitably qualified graduates from a local secondary school to pursue full-time studies at Bermuda College in the Associate Degree Programme majoring in Insurance or Mathematics.
CONDITIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Applicants must have Bermudian status or pending within 12 months of application.2. Applicants must be eligible for entry without conditions to an Associate in Business Administration or Arts and Sciences programme of study.3. Applicants must intend to complete the requirements for an Associate in Arts (Business Administration), Associate in Business Administration or Associate in Science (Actuarial) with concentrations in Insurance or Mathematics at Bermuda College.4. Students already studying at Bermuda College must qualify as sophomores in the Associate in Business Administration or Arts and Sciences programme with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.00.
SELECTION	The Selection Committee will base its decision on the academic achievements and aptitude of applicants. The Committee reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship in the event of unsatisfactory work or conduct.
DOCUMENTS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Completed application form.2. Official transcripts of the applicant's complete secondary school record and post secondary school record.3. Two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must come from a current teacher who knows the applicant and his/her academic abilities, and one from an adult who knows the applicant on a personal basis.4. Proof of Bermudian Status or eligibility.
APPLICATION DEADLINE	June 30
INTERVIEW	Short-listed candidates will be interviewed by the BFIS Scholarship Committee in July.
